Breast disease

Rape victim's lawyer is the accused

Gondal, On May 3, Sagira, a minor working in the modeling field in Rajkot, filed a complaint of rape against Amit Khunt. After that, Sagira, 5, Amit Khunt committed suicide by hanging himself in Ribada, Gondal. There are many ups and downs in this case. After that, Sagira, who complained of rape, gave the names of the police officers who forced her to give a statement under threat in the Gondal court in June, in which a total of 28 names were listed, including former MLA Jayrajsinh Jadeja, his son Ganesh Jadeja, DCP Jagdish Bangarwa, DYSP K. G. Jhala and 6 PIs. This case has been in the news since last May and her female lawyer Bhumi Patel has been standing by the victim but now there has been a twist in the case. The victim's father has filed an FIR against his own lawyer Bhumi Patel for revealing the identity of his minor daughter. The minor's father has filed a complaint against Bhumi Patel that the lawyer has violated the POCSO Act by revealing the identity of the victim and also shared the details of the parents. It is well mentioning that a case was registered under the POCSO Act at Gondal Police Station on May 5, 2025, in which lawyer Bhumi Patel was appointed as the legal representative of the victim.

Violation of POCSO Act is a serious offence. Disclosure of the identity of the victim under the POCSO Act is a serious offence. This act is a direct violation of Section 228(A) IPC and Section 33(2) of the POCSO Act.

The case took a new turn when the rape victim Sagira filed a complaint. There was a major turn in the case last June.

Brics Rio summit: A double espresso shot for big



The 17th summit of Brics was held in Rio de Janeiro from 6 to 7 July under trying circumstances, with Israel and US military strikes against Iran—a new Brics member—dominating the immediate backdrop. Furthermore, the failure of the Brics foreign ministers to produce a joint statement at their April meeting had raised doubts about whether Rio would succeed in crafting a joint declaration at all. In this light, Brazil, as the chair and host, scored a notable success, delivering an impressive summit. Prime Minister Narendra Modi, therefore, commended President Lula for the summit's excellent organisation, which gave participants a "fresh momentum and vitality." Modi added, "And let me say—the energy we have received isn't just an espresso; it is a double espresso shot."

Besides the Rio Declaration, the summit produced three other important documents: on climate finance, the global governance of artificial intelligence, and the partnership for the elimination of socially determined diseases. To appreciate the value and importance of what was achieved at Rio, it is necessary to analyse the summit declaration, the Rio Declaration, and the Rio Declaration is longer than the Rio Declaration. It renewed the call for the finalisation and adoption of the Comprehensive Convention on International Terrorism, which remains elusive. The third section relating to deepening international economic trade and financial cooperation welcomed the results of the "Strategy for Brics Economic Policy 2025". It encouraged the ongoing expansion of the New Development Bank's

(NDB) membership and the strengthening of its governance framework. Para 50 makes it clear that the work on the "Brics Cross-Border Payments Initiative" will continue. The plan is to realise the potential for "greater interoperability of Brics payment systems". The last two sections, which pertain to combating climate change and promoting sustainable, fair, and inclusive development, as well as partnership for the promotion of human, social, and cultural development, contain a wealth of ideas for ongoing and new projects based on cooperation within the expanded Brics family and beyond.

Focus on the Founders The thoughts of the Brics leadership were also reflected in the statements of their key leaders. President Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva's opening remarks at the first session, devoted to peace, security, and reform of global governance, drew international attention. He called Brics "an heir of the Non-Aligned Movement". Pointing out that in 2025 Brazil hosted the fourth Brics summit, he added, "Of all of them, this one is the most place amid the most adverse scenario," marked by "an unprecedented collapse of multilateralism." He made a strong plea for investment in reform and peace. Regretting that it was always easier to invest in war than peace, he noted, "It is easier to designate 5 per cent of the GDP to military spending than to allocate the 0.7 per cent that has been provided for Official Development Assistance." He believed that the world still has the opportunity to lay the groundwork for "a civilizational governance model". Remarks at the same session by Prime Minister Narendra Modi were brief but crisp. From West Asia to Europe, he said, the world is surrounded by disputes and tensions. "The path to peace is the only option for the good of humanity," he stated. On reform, he said that global institutions without adequate representation for the Global South are "like a mobile

phone with a SIM card but no network". He devoted attention to the scourge of international terrorism, asserting, "Condemning terrorism must be a matter of principle and not just of convenience."

The media made an unnecessary play of the absence of President Xi Jinping. Premier Li Qiang represented China well. He expressed his nation's readiness to work with fellow Brics members to make global governance "more just, equitable, efficient, and well-ordered".
